



Prepare for launch!

The new online pension administration system, PLANet, is coming soon. PEPP staff are currently in training preparing for our launch day.

What to look for:

Before PLANet officially launches, you can expect communications and training from our PEPP Customer Focus Coordinators, Jen Nelson and Jenny Davison. Training resources will soon be available on the PEPP website under the *Employer Tab*, including:

- Quick Step Guides - short how-to PDFs for some of your most common tasks;
- Employer Guide - a comprehensive resource for everything related to PLANet; and
- Webinars - virtual live one-hour demo presentations, a chance to have your questions answered.

An official launch date has yet to be released, but employers will be provided all training resources prior to launch to review materials and attend webinars.

New login information

With the implementation of Employer PLANet, employers will now require login credentials. Employers who have completed a *PLANet User Information and Authorization* form or survey will have logins sent directly to their email shortly after the launch date.
